We meet in person at the Maltings and simultaneously have a Zoom connection. The choice of option is entirely up to the individual member.

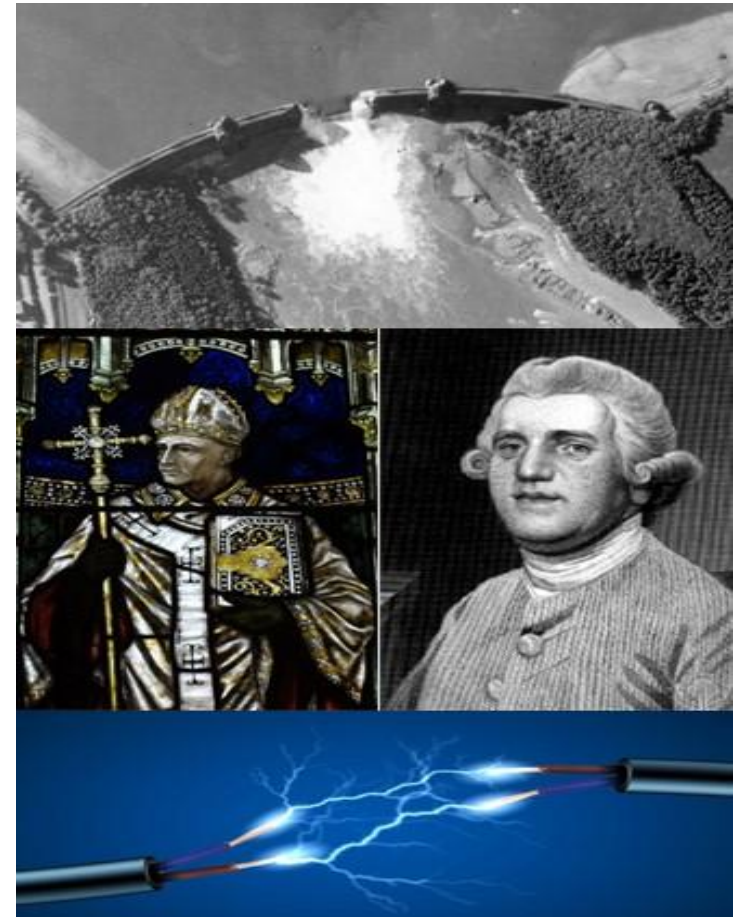
